

Planting to Green Central Plant

Plants and trees have been added around the Minato Mirai 21 Central Plant to mark the 30th anniversary of the founding of Minato Mirai 21 District Heating and Cooling Co., Ltd. (MM21 DHC) and to increase the amount of greenery on the premises. Located at the start of Sakura-dori (the cherry-lined street stretching across the Minato Mirai 21 area) and at its address 1-1 Sakuragi-cho (a neighborhood named for cherry blossoms), the newly planted early-blossoming Japanese cherry trees will serve as a harbinger of spring along Sakura-dori.

Hedges have also been added along the length of the approach to the plant. These hedges visibly and eloquently add to the greenery, creating a comfortable space that exhibits the changing seasons in a manner that works well with the other hedges in the adjacent area. Although still young, these newly planted plants will grow to make greater and even greener statements.
