

MM21 DHC installs additional emergency oil tanks

MM21 DHC installed additional emergency oil tanks at the Central Plant in September 2020.

The MM21 DHC Central Plant uses electricity and city gas to produce cold water and steam. A kerosene generator and boiler for emergency use are installed in case energy infrastructure is shut down by a disaster.

The installation of additional emergency oil tanks have made it possible to keep a 150kL kerosene stockpile. This means it is possible to maintain supply of cold water and heat for approximately three days even with the energy infrastructure shut down and without supplies of kerosene from tanker trucks.

Going forward, MM21 DHC will strengthen the business continuity plan (BCP) and strive to supply safe and reliable heat.
